POBLACHT NA H EIREANN. THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC TO THE PEOPLE OF IRELAND.

MISSION AND PURPOSES.—In the name of God and of the dead generations from which we receive our old tradition of heroism, Ireland, through no fault of her children, is her flag and altar, her law and freedom.

Being oppressed and treated her without through her secret revolutionary organization, the Irish Republican Brotherhood, and through her open military organization, the Irish Volunteers and the Irish Citizen Army, having patriotically prepared her struggle, being resolutely united for the right moment to reveal herself, Ireland, before the world, and supported by her sister Republics in America and by public opinion in Europe, not relying in the first instance upon strength, she declares to the world her independence.

We declare the right of the people of Ireland to the ownership of Ireland, and to the exclusive control of Irish destinies, to be sovereign and indefeasible. The long oppression of that right, as a people's right not granted but an independent right, not to be given or extinguished except by the destruction of the Irish people. It is hereby asserted that Irish people have reacquired their right to national freedom and sovereignty, so many during the past three hundred years they have almost lost it. Standing on the fundamental rights and upon asserting it to every eye in the face of the world, we hereby proclaim the Irish Republic as a sovereign independent State, and we pledge our lives and our treasure for its maintenance as the cause of the freedom of all nations and of the individual among the nations.

The Irish Republic is founded on and based upon the abolition of every privilege and distinction. The Republic guarantees religious and civil liberty, equal rights and equal opportunities to all its citizens, and declares its resolve to pursue the happiness and prosperity of the whole nation and of all its parts, cherishing all the rights of the citizen equally, and extending its assistance to all who are unable to provide for their own maintenance, when such assistance is demanded.

Our arms have brought the oppressors from the subject to the free, independent, Republic, representing the whole people of Ireland and committed by the majority to all her men and women, the Provisional Government, hereby proclaims, will administer the laws and orders, which the Provisional Government shall give.

We place on record of the Irish Republic under the protection of the Irish people, whose freedom we desire, that we will not use our arms and our power to maintain or to extend our authority over any other people, territory or nation. In this sense we have committed ourselves to the world, and we hereby declare that the Provisional Government will administer the laws and orders, which the Provisional Government shall give.
